**Student Accident Coverage Information**

Dear Parent:

Since the North Boone School District is an eligible member of the Workers' Compensation Self-Insurance Trust (WCSIT), Student Accident Coverage will be provided for the 2011-12 school year for each enrolled K-12 student. Attached is a brochure that describes this coverage provided at no cost to you through the school district's participation in WCSIT. No enrollment is necessary for the school time Student Accident Coverage. This insurance is accident coverage only and will not replace your current health insurance.

An identification card is included on the brochure. Please cut out the ID card and carry it with you. It should be presented to the hospitals and doctors along with your primary insurance ID card (if applicable) whenever you seek medical attention for a school related injury.

**Please read the brochure and retain it as a summary of coverage.**

The Student Accident brochure also provides for the purchase or additional **optional** coverage for grades 9-12 tackle football and for 24-hour coverage. The brochure provides pricing information for the two optional coverages.

The procedure for purchasing *optional coverage* is as follows:

1. Complete the Optional Enrollment Form that is provided as part of the Student Accident Coverage brochure or you can enroll on-line with a credit card or PayPal at [www.wcsit-isda.com/sac](http://www.wcsit-isda.com/sac). Each student must be enrolled separately.
2. Provide payment in the form of a check or money order made payable to **Illinois School District Agency (ISDA)** in the correct amount for the type of coverage(s) desired. **Do not send cash.** You may also pay on-line at [www.wcsit-isda.com/sac](http://www.wcsit-isda.com/sac). Your student is eligible for coverage because of the school's membership in WCSIT. However, the Student Accident Coverage is issued by the ISDA.
3. You should mail the completed Optional Coverage Enrollment Form with full payment in the correct amount for the type of coverage(s) desired to the following address: Illinois School District Agency (ISDA), 6400 Eagle Way, Chicago, IL 60678-1640.
4. Certificates of Coverage for Optional Coverage will be forwarded to you upon receipt by the school.
5. Optional Coverage can be purchased after the start of the school year. However, please be aware that the effective date for the 24-hour Optional Coverage will correspond with the **receipt of the Optional Coverage Enrollment Form and the full payment by the ISDA.** The effective date for the football coverage will be the later of the first day of sanctioned practice as defined by IHSA guidelines or the date we receive premium payment. Payment will not be pro-rated or refunded for purchase of optional coverage after the start of the school year.

With regard to filing a claim, you must contact the school and complete a Student Accident Claim Form. Please read the Claim Form for complete details on how to submit a claim. You must file a claim with your own health insurance carrier. The Student Accident plan is designed to pay for expenses which are not reimbursed by your current health insurance. The school district and medical/dental providers are not responsible for filing a student accident claim.
