School is out at North Boone School District #200, but some of the school libraries will be busy this summer. The libraries at Capron Elementary, North Boone Upper Elementary, and Poplar Grove Elementary will all be open weekly from June 14 to August 3 for students to check out books, participate in the summer reading program, and use the computers. "Since the school district is not served by a public library, this is an important program in order to keep students reading and improving their skills", said Jane Lenser, District Media Specialist. The project is being funded through grants and gifts from the President's Discretionary Fund of the Community Foundation of Northern Illinois, North Boone Board of Education, North Boone Education Foundation, and Poplar Grove PTO.

Poplar Grove's library hours will be Tuesdays from 9:00 a.m. to noon with story time at 10:30 a.m. North Boone Upper Elementary School's library will be open on Tuesday evenings from 5:00 to 8:00 p.m. Capron's hours will be on Wednesdays from 9:00 a.m. to noon and story time will be at 9:30 a.m. Students are invited to visit the libraries even if they do not attend that particular school.
