**CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL**

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Education was called to order at 6:35 p.m. by President Don Ward.

A motion was made by Mrs. Balsley and seconded by Mr. Crull to approve the Agenda as amended:

The motion was carried by unanimous voice vote.

**SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT**

Dr. Baule reported that the traditional teacher in-service schedule today was changed in order to hold a district-wide meeting. He thanked the district's employee benefits broker, Miller, Buettner & Parrott, for providing for the cost of the breakfast.

Dr. Baule informed everyone that the class of 1960 toured their former high school, which is now the middle school, and new high school as a part of their 50<sup>th</sup> reunion on August 12, 2010. Mr. Ward gave the tour and Mr. Novak provided a shuttle between the buildings and opened the buildings for the tour.

Dr. Baule reviewed the ACT results from the Class of 2010 and the 5-year trend data. The only area in which the scores increased was in reading. ACT has established the scores to be used as the benchmark for college readiness. North Boone is slightly better than average in English but

other areas have been identified as needing more attention. He did note that he had spoken with ISBE and a correction will be made in the district's AYP.

Dr. Baule reported on the progress achieved in identifying and correcting setup decisions made when PowerSchool was originally installed as well as other issues. TechCare has completed several items and has been very responsive to our network needs. However, some issues cannot be resolved until everyone is back in their buildings and using the systems. Fox Valley has been much more responsive in addressing issues and connections between buildings.

Dr. Baule advised that a bid will be put out for the desktop computers necessary to replace the laptops at the middle and high schools. In accordance with the decision made by the Technology Subcommittee, the bid request will specify HP desktop computers. He explained that the laptops are not as robust or reliable as desktops.

Dr. Baule informed the Board that in response to a request by Poplar Grove Elementary, the North Boone Educational Foundation appropriated \$51,800 for the purchase of interactive whiteboards and laptops. He recommended that the district move to all SmartBoards as they are the most reliable and are the standard by which other boards are compared. Fourteen SmartBoards will be purchased for Poplar Grove Elementary out of the funds received from the Foundation; two for North Boone Upper Elementary out of Title 1 funds and three for North Boone High School out of the technology budget. North Boone Middle School prefers a student response system. If they are put out for bid, the earliest the district will receive and install the boards will be the middle of November. He explained the reason that very few bids would be made on this type of equipment, and the Board agreed not to request bids for this equipment. The district would then go with the vendor who had offered the best price, which is COTG for the SmartBoard 77" for \$3,476 per room installed.

Dr. Baule extended a special thank you to Barb Sager for her skill and attention to detail at the recent bus accident drill. He also commended Sue Steffen for her excellent job in keeping record. Overall, he felt that the drill went very well and looked forward to more drills of this nature in the future.

Dr. Baule reported that Ann Mylin met with the mentors and new teachers on Thursday, August 19<sup>th</sup>. He commented that she has done a good job in her selection of mentors as well as in her organization of the program.

Dr. Baule asked the Board to contact his office if they are interested to attending the Ottosen, Britz law conference on September 22, 2010.

**Other Committee Reports**

Mr. Kinser reported that the date for the next Technology Subcommittee meeting is yet to be determined.

Mrs. Zwart reported that the Community Involvement Committee last met on August 4, 2010. The next Community Involvement Committee meeting was scheduled for Wednesday, September 1, 2010 at 5:30 p.m. at the high school.

The Committee is starting to sell parking passes for football. Three hundred letters were sent out to all our vendors to solicit advertising as a part of fund raising. Poplar Grove State Bank has offered up to \$1000 to sponsor our sports teams. A special meeting may be scheduled for September 13 for the Board to consider this offer as well as a change in the rate charged for parking passes.

Dr. Baule reported that Ms. Moore, the district's new Special Education Director, has a very good understanding of where North Boone needs to go with Special Education. She is doing very well working with our Business Manager and the principals in sharing her knowledge.

### UNFINISHED BUSINESS

**A. Consideration of Middle School Soccer**

Dr. Baule informed the Board the cost of a soccer coach would be approximately \$2,200 plus the cost of a couple away games.

Mr. Kinser commented that because soccer is coed, it is a little harder to compete for players. However, as the team progresses, it will help the high school program.

A motion was made by Mrs. Balsley and seconded by Mr. Kinser to reinstate middle school soccer if a minimum of 15 students can be recruited to participate.

The motion was carried by unanimous roll call.

### NEW BUSINESS

**A. 2010-2011 Tentative Budget to be Placed on Display**

Mrs. Nelson stated that the 2010-2011 tentative budget to be placed on display has very minor changes to that approved last month such as more definitive amounts to be

received from the state by the next Board meeting. The 2010-2011 Tentative Budget will be on display for 30 days at the district office as of August 25, 2010.

A motion was made by Mrs. Zwart and seconded by Mr. Crull to approve the 2010-2011 Tentative Budget.

The motion was carried by unanimous roll call.

**B. Set Time for Hearing on the 2010-2011 Budget**

A motion was made by Mrs. Balsley and seconded by Mr. Kinser to set a time for a hearing on the 2010-2011 Budget at the September 27 Board meeting.

The motion was carried by unanimous voice vote.

**C. Request from Regional Attendance Cooperative**

Mrs. Troller advised that the Regional Attendance Cooperative provides truancy intervention services for students in kindergarten through the first semester of 8<sup>th</sup> grade only.

A motion was made by Mrs. Balsley and seconded by Mr. Crull to approve the Regional Attendance Cooperative request for a contribution of \$2,007.

The motion failed on unanimous roll call.

**D. Surplus and Sale of Bus**

It was requested that Bus #23, a 2003 Blue Bird Bus, be declared surplus and sold to Midwest Transit for \$17,000.

A motion was made by Mrs. Balsley and seconded by Mr. Crull to surplus Bus #23 and sell it to Midwest Transit for \$17,000.

The motion was carried by unanimous roll call.

**E. Bid Recommendation for Bakery Items**

The Board discussed the possibility of asking the vendor to hold pricing for one year. Although five bid packages were requested, only one response was received. The district's current vendor for bakery items, IBC – Hostess Brands, bid for requested items was from 4-50% lower than their current billing.

A motion was made by Mr. Crull and seconded by Mr. Kinser to approve the bid by IBC – Hostess Brands for bakery items.

The motion was carried by unanimous roll call.

**F. Bid Recommendation for General Groceries**

The Board discussed the pricing variation in the bids, which was because of quantity and serving size. Although 13 bid packages were requested, only 6 responses were received. The lowest bidders were Joe & Ross Ice Cream, Gordon Food Service and Fox River Foods.

A motion was made by Mr. Crull and seconded by Mrs. Zwart to approve the bids made by Joe & Ross Ice Cream, Gordon Food Service and Fox River Foods.

The motion was carried by unanimous roll call.
