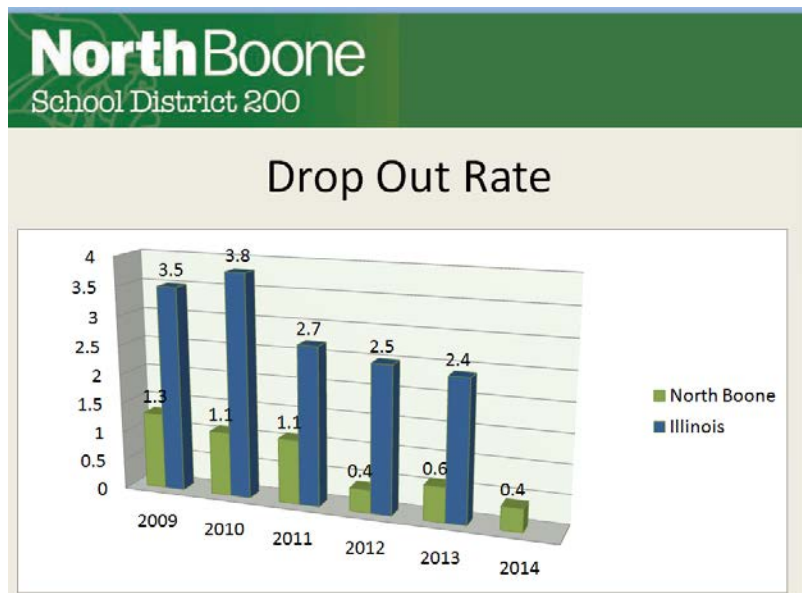

### State of the Schools Address Given to Belvidere Chamber

Dr. Baule provided a summary of the district's progress over the past year to members of the Belvidere Chamber of Commerce at the Boone County Council on Aging Center on Thursday, August 28, 2014. Dr. Houselog from District 100 also spoke.

Dr. Baule's presentation highlighted increases in Advanced Placement courses and success on the AP exams at NBHS. Over the past several years, the failure rate at NBHS and NBMS has also decreased while the graduation rate has grown. Dr. Baule also spoke about the district's 1:1 tablet program and the fiscal and facilities issues facing the district. Dr. Baule also spoke about the use
