Skyler Yunk Sets Three New School Track Records

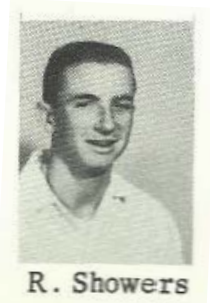
North Boone Junior Skyler Yunk broke NBHS track records three times this year. On May 1, Skyler broke the 3200 meter run record of 9:56 set by Dan Shriver in 2000 with a time of 9:49:89 at Oregon's Art Carlson Classic. He then broke the 1600 meter run record of 4:38.8 that had been held by Rog Showers since 1957 with a time of 4:38.32 at the Genoa-Kingston High School Invitational on May 9, 2015. Skyler is the son of Scott and Debbie Yunk of rural Poplar Grove.

Yunk then broke his own record in the 3200 meter run at the sectional track meet with a time of 9:47 which qualifies him for the state track meet in Class 2A. We wish Skyler the best at the state track meet this weekend.
