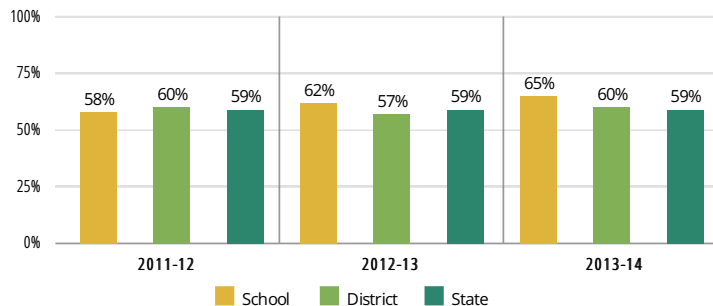
## Academic Growth

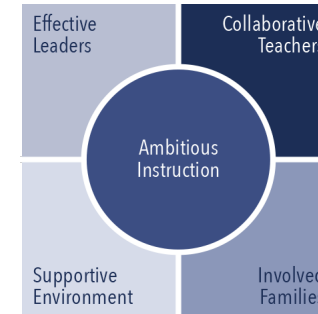
The percentage of students who meet or exceed standards on the Illinois Standards Achievement Test (ISAT).

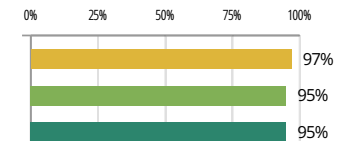

## Student Attendance and Mobility

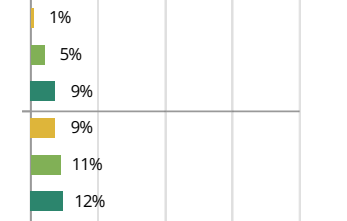
### Attendance Rate

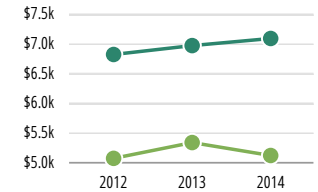

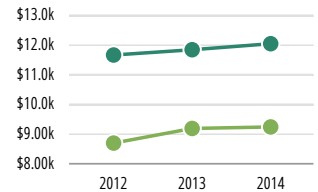
