CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order at 3:45 p.m. by Mr. Joe Haverly. STATE REPORT CARD

Dr. Greenlee reviewed the Illinois State Report Card with the Committee and spoke to the overall trends. He felt teachers were working hard to make changes, but those efforts were not always reflective in the charts.

Mrs. Nachampassack stated MAPS assessments were three times per year, and they are able to review individual results immediately. Mrs. Doetch pointed out that they can track and document how long each student takes on a test and how they scored. Mrs. Saveley noted with PARCC, they cannot see those scores until the student has moved on to the next grade. Mr. Haverly suggested having an in-house assessment in order to eliminate the wait for test results. Mrs. Lilja remarked that MAPS shows how we perform on a national level, and PARCC identifies how our District compares to the state. Mr. Rudy asked Mr. Haverly what kind of data would be relevant to the Board. Mr. Haverly replied that the Board would like to see a summary of everything before they make financial decisions.

HIGH SCHOOL COURSE PROPOSALS

Three High School course proposals were discussed: College Algebra, Spanish 4 and Spanish 3 Honors. Mr. Hubert described the algebra course and the potential impact on other department offerings. He also shared this could potentially improve the caliber of students enrolled in AP Calculus. Mr. Geiger presented the Spanish course proposals, including the goals, objectives and justifications. Mr. Geiger also added there is already student interest in these additional courses. The Committee agreed to move forward on all three proposals to present to the Board for approval.

CURRICULUM GUIDE

Mr. Hubert presented the Curriculum Guide, and advised the Committee that they were removing Adobe Photoshop and Adult Living for the 2018-2019 school year. Mr. Haverly asked to have the Running Start information included.

MASTERY MANAGER

Mr. Hubert gave a presentation of Mastery Manager, a tool that is used at the High School level. He described how this can tie state standards to any test or worksheet question. Mr. Hubert also shared that they have the ability to review student performance, down to their understanding of certain concepts. He would like Master Manager data to drive conversation and discussion with teachers, and sees it as tool to help one another.
