⇒ **Weapons or "look alike" weapons including knives, guns, bullets, swords, etc.**

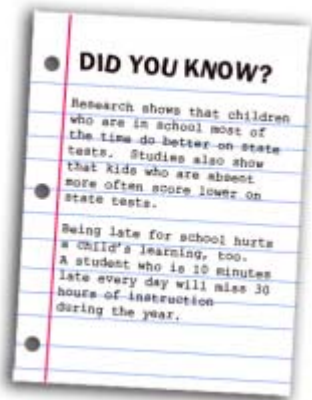
Simply put, if the intent of the costume is to scare, or be scary, it is not to be worn at school. Thank you for your cooperation.
