Fees:

- 100% of the current year fees are due and payable when enrollment is before or within the 1st semester of the school year. Families registering before July 31, 2025, and **PAY IN FULL** will receive a \$25.00 discount per child. Beginning August 1, 2025, families will pay the regular board-approved fee rate.

The District reserves the right to pursue collections if fees are not paid in a timely manner.

- 50% of the current year fees are due and payable when enrollment is after the start of the 2nd semester of the school year.

Refund of Fees:

- 100% of the fees are refundable when withdrawal is prior to the start of the school year.
- 50% of the fees are refundable when a withdrawal is after the start of the school year and prior to the end of the 1st semester.
- No refund is given when withdrawal is after the start of the 2nd semester of the school year.
