COLD AND FLU SEASON

Please remember if your child has a fever, they must remain fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication before they can return to school. Please do not medicate your child and send them to school if they have a fever. The same rule applies to diarrhea and/or vomiting. This is to help prevent the spread of illness to other students and staff. This district policy will be strictly enforced. Remember the key to staying germ free is washing your hands frequently, covering coughs and sneezes, staying home when you or your child are ill .

PRESCHOOL ATTENDANCE POLICY

All Preschool students are expected to attend school every day. Your child's attendance is a MANDATORY REOUIREMENT in order to

participate in this program. Attendance is taken upon arrival every day. As a courtesy, we ask that you contact the school by 8:00 am / 11:30 am if your child will not be attending that day. Since our site is regulated by the state for this program, we are required to report attendance on an ongoing basis. We understand that sometimes your child may be ill or there may be a family situation. We ask that you commit to the following:

- Your child arrives to their session **ON TIME** and are picked up on time.
- You make every effort to schedule doctor appointments before or after your child's session time.
- If you have an appointment and arrive late, please bring a doctor's excuse.
- If your child is absent, you must provide an excuse when they return with the date and reason.

A few things to know about enrolling a child in Capron Elementary School

- All registrations for Capron Elementary school are done **online**, via the **North Boone School District Website** at www.nbcusd.org
- Please have ALL documents together BEFORE you begin the registration process. All documents must be provided at the time of registration.
- Your child's legal name (the name that appears on the birth certificate) will be used on all official school records. Please enroll with their legal name only.
- Illinois law requires a child be five years old on or before September 1 to be enrolled in Kindergarten.
- If you are interested in the North Boone School district Preschool, please call 815-569-2314 to schedule a screening.

• Students moving to North Boone District from another school will need a withdrawal form from their previous school of attendance and copies of any academic records which could assist in placing the student in appropriate classes. The new school will then request school records from the previous school once the student has officially enrolled.

Frequently Asked Questions

- " Parent Drop-off starts at 7:45am
- " Class Start-time is 8:00am (Pre-k PM classes 11:30am)
- " Parent Pick-up time is 2:45pm (Pre-k PM classes 2:15pm)
- " Late/Tardy students after 8:00am (Pre-k PM class 11:30am) must be signed in by a parent or guardian
- " Dismissal Changes must be submitted by 1pm
- " Doctor/Absence Notes must be turned into the front office the day after the absence

SCHOOL SAFETY

We have been experiencing an increase in the number of cars dropping off and picking up students in the front of the school and the safety of our students has become a growing concern. To help all of our students remain safe, please follow the guidelines below when dropping off and picking up your child.

- 1) No car can be left without the driver in a fire lane. The striped line in front of the school is a fire lane. We must maintain a clear path for the fire department at all times.
- 2) If you need to come into the school for any reason, your car must be parked in the designated spot. Not in the fire lane!
- 3) Please do not park behind the cars that are parked in the designated spots.
- 4) Please do not park in the designated wheelchair/handicapped parking spots unless you have the proper permit.
- 5) No cars are allowed in the bus loop area at any time.

If we can have everyone's cooperation with this, we can make our drop off /pick up area safer for all of our students and more effective for our parents.
