COLD AND FLU SEASON

Please remember if your child has a fever, they must remain fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication before they can return to school. Please do not medicate your child and send them to school if they have a fever. The same rule applies to diarrhea and/or vomiting. This is to help prevent the spread of illness to other students and staff. This district policy will be strictly enforced. Remember the key to staying germ free is washing your hands frequently, covering coughs and sneezes, staying home when you or your child are ill .

PRESCHOOL ATTENDANCE POLICY

All Preschool students are expected to attend school every day. Your child's attendance is a **MANDATORY REQUIREMENT** in order to participate in this program. Attendance is taken upon arrival every day. As a courtesy, we ask that you contact the school by 8:00 am / 11:30 am if your child will not be attending that day. Since our site is regulated by the state for this program, we are required to report attendance on an ongoing basis. We understand that sometimes your child may be ill or there may be a family situation. We ask that you commit to the following:

- Your child arrives to their session **ON TIME** and are picked up on time.
- You make every effort to schedule doctor appointments before or after your child's session time.
- If you have an appointment and arrive late, please bring a doctor's excuse.
- If your child is absent, you must provide an excuse when they return with the date and reason.

Kindergarten and new student registration – now open!

Registration for students new to NBCUSD including new incoming kindergarten students, is now open. A child whose fifth birthday falls on or before Sept. 1, 2024, is eligible to enroll in kindergarten for the 2024-2025 school year. Please have your child's birth certificate ready to send to school or upload online. Parents must present two forms of proof that they reside in the attendance zone in which they are enrolling their student. Acceptable proofs are listed on the District website. Before your child can start school, he or she must have a physical examination. Doctor appointments should be made as early as possible as appointments for physicals are limited. Questions? Contact the school office.

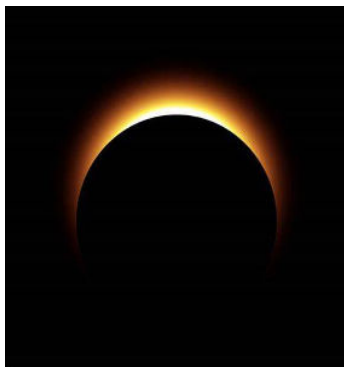
A few things to know about enrolling a child in Capron Elementary School

- All registrations for Capron Elementary school are done **online**, via the **North Boone School District Website** at www.nbcusd.org
- Please have ALL documents together BEFORE you begin the registration process. All documents must be provided at the time of registration.
- Your child's legal name (the name that appears on the birth certificate) will be used on all official school records. Please enroll with their legal name only.
- Illinois law requires a child be five years old on or before September 1 to be enrolled in Kindergarten.
- If you are interested in the North Boone School district Preschool, please call 815-569-2314 to schedule a screening.

ECLIPSE AT CAPRON

On Monday, April 8th Capron School will witness a solar eclipse. The eclipse will begin at approximately 1:40 PM and it will gradually get darker outside until it is estimated to be at its darkest around 3:00 PM and then the sky will start to get lighter. The eclipse should end at approximately 4:18 PM.

We were donated some eclipse safe glasses for all students and staff that will be at school on Monday, April 8th. We did send home a



permission slip with all families on Monday April 1st or parents to give consent for their students to be outside, with glasses on, for viewing some of the eclipse.
