- ◆ Ensure that your child knows his or her addition, subtraction, and multiplication facts for his or her grade level.
- ◆ Be sure to check your student's red folder or agenda daily.
- ◆ Talk with your child daily about what he or she is learning. Ask what they are learning, not what they did that day in school. Communicate regularly with your child's teacher about your child's performance.

The Poplar Grove Elementary staff and I want to wish you a very successful 2019! A successful year may be one where you have time to spend reading to your child. Any child in elementary school loves to be read to. If you read to him/her at a level that is well above his/her reading level then the child's vocabulary will increase and help your student be a better reader and writer. 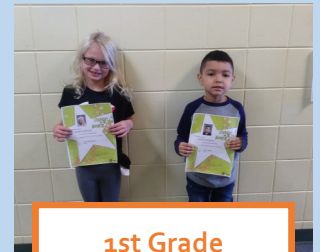

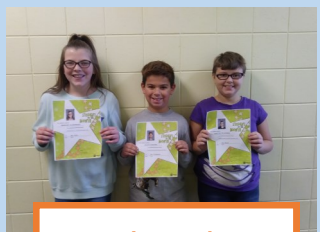
