

Guidelines for Application to the North Boone Education Foundation Grant Committee

The North Boone Education Foundation (NBEF) exists to promote and encourage the enhancement of programs and services within the North Boone School District. The grants committee of NBEF will receive applications for grants to enrich the educational experience. Applications must be submitted by May 31th of each year to North Boone Education Foundation, 6248 North Boone School Road, Poplar Grove, IL 61065. The projects chosen for funding will be announced by July 1st of each year. Funds will be available on September 1st of each year. All North Boone District 200 personnel are eligible to apply for these grants. The following stipulations apply:

- 1. The beneficiary must be a student or group of students enrolled in the North Boone District.**
- 2. The purpose of the project must be secular, not religious.**
- 3. The purpose shall be to enhance and/or enrich the student experience and foster the development of intellectual, academic, artistic, musical or leadership skills.**
- 4. Grants are for one-year projects. The Education Foundation will not continue funding the project or its replication beyond a year.**
- 5. All grade levels and curriculum areas will be considered.**
- 6. Foundation funds will only support programs, activities and purchases, which are not part of the District's regular operating budget.**
- 7. Foundation funds will not be appropriated for salary/stipends, purchase of textbooks for regular curriculum or for the purchase of general operational supplies.**
- 8. Preference shall be given to an opportunity for more, as opposed to fewer, students.**
- 9. Preference shall be given to an opportunity not eligible for, or likely to receive, funds from other organizations, foundations, or clubs.**
- 10. Full or partial funding may be granted.**
