- Due to the overwhelming number of students charging lunches and snack milk, effective immediately any students' account that falls below -\$5.00 will have their lunch card pulled and receive an emergency peanut butter lunch. If your student receives snack milk their snack milk card will be held and no milk will be received. Student's cards will be returned once the lunch account is brought current. 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Math Tips

New Year, New Goals!

Out with the old and in with the new year! This is a great time to make some resolutions and make a fresh start. When it comes to school work, does your child practice math every day in some way? Just like reading daily helps students become better readers, daily math practice is also important. A few minutes a day can have a **HUGE** impact, so here are a few ways to squeeze in some math:

Going for a drive? Have your child . . .

- count to a specific number and then go backwards!
- skip count
- play "I Spy" with numbers and have them find numbers on signs, license plates, anywhere!
- tell you the time that you leave, then the time you arrive and figure out elapsed time (how long did it take to get there?

At the store? Have your child . . .

- count the number of items you are buying
- compare prices on items (Which is more? Which is less? How much more or less?)
- estimate the price of each item and keep track of the total amount (when you check out they can see how close they are)
- pay for the item(s) and count out the correct money needed (or count the change received)
- figure out how many more you need (I need 8 cans of sauce and I already have 3, how many more do I need?)

In the kitchen? Have your child . . .

- help make dinner (measuring ingredients, follow directions, etc.)
- count (set the table and count spoons, count the number of boxes on the shelf, etc.)
- tell you about what they are doing in math and have them teach YOU how to do it
- play a board game for a few minutes while you wait for dinner to finish cooking (even a deck of cards can become many different math games: Go Fish to match numbers, WAR addition or multiplication, etc.)

On the computer or tablet? Have your child . . .

play a math game for 5-10 minutes BEFORE playing a game of their choice (there are many free math apps & games online: abcya.com, xtramath.org, or multiplication.com are just a few!

Challenge your child(ren) to take a few minutes every day to think and talk about math and see how it makes a difference!
