The PARCC Assessment (Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers) is the required assessment for the State of Illinois, replacing the ISAT and PSAE. PARCC testing assesses a student's knowledge and understanding of the new Illinois State Standards.

Students at Poplar Grove Elementary will be taking the PARCC tests at the following times:

3rd Grade ELA (English/Language Arts) – Week of March 6th – 10th

4th Grade ELA (English/Language Arts) – Week of March 13th – 17th

3rd Grade Math – Week of March 20th – 24th

4th Grade Math – Week of April 3rd – 7th

Make-ups – Week of April 10th -14th

The results of these state tests will be reported to you on the School Report Card in the fall. We will review state test results along with other information to help us improve our school program. In addition, you will receive information about your child's performance on the state tests he or she took.

You can help your child do his or her best on the tests by:

Making sure, if possible, that your child attends school on the days of testing

Making sure your child gets a good night's sleep the night before testing

Providing breakfast on the mornings of testing

Reminding your child to ask the teacher questions if he or she does not understand the test directions Letting your child know that you have confidence in his or her ability to do his or her best Advising your child <u>not to worry</u> about the test – just do the best he or she can

Please call your child's teacher if you want additional information or have further questions about these tests.
