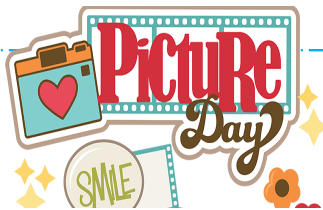


Every Friday, we will pull **5 names per grade** to win a prize!

## A few things from the nurse...

### **Import information to know if your child is ill:**

In order to protect the health and safety of all of our students and staff, it is important to be aware of the North Boone School District COVID Protocols and the Sick Day Guidelines. Parents and guardians please know that you **MUST** keep your student home if he or she shows any signs of illness. Symptoms that we must exclude students and staff for include fever, headache, nausea, diarrhea, vomiting, cough, nasal congestion/runny nose, loss of sense of smell/taste, muscle/body aches, or abdominal pain from unknown cause, or fatigue from unknown cause. If your child exhibits any of these symptoms please keep them home and call the school to report his or her absence. Thank you!

**Attention Parents of 6th Grade Students:** Dental Visit Forms are due May 15th so please schedule your student's dental exam soon to get these forms turned in on time. If you need the appropriate form to take to your dentist please have your child stop by the nurse's office. Thank you!

**Attention Parents of 5th Grade Students:** There are health requirements for students entering 6th grade next year. A school health exam with updated immunizations within the last calendar year prior to the first day of school. Dental exam dated after 11/15/2020. A sports physical does not count for school health exams. Health forms are due by the first day of school and should be directed to the appropriate building nurse via email, fax or regular mail.
