- When students hand in their physicals to the office, we notify them of the expiration date. We ask that parents keep track of the expiration dates too. If a student's physical runs out during the season, they are unable to play until they get a current physical. This is an IHSA requirement, and it helps to protect the student from any unforeseen health issues that might put them at risk. The office also shares a document with the coaches that we keep up-to-date, so coaches have access to insure the safety of their athletes. If you have questions about the dates of physicals, please call to find out when a current physical ends for your student.
- If you have an issue with how something is being handled, we ask that you schedule a time to meet with the coach 24 hours after the issue to allow everyone time to cool down and think about the matter. This helps to decrease letting our emotions getting the best of us. Please honor the rule, and if after the meeting with the coach, you are still not satisfied, we ask that you set up a meeting with Aaron Sullivan, our Athletic Director.
