I have been at North Boone Upper Elementary for 5 years.

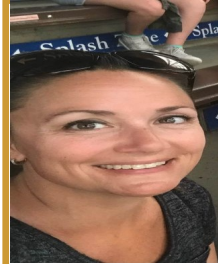
My favorite thing about North Boone Upper Elementary is working with amazing staff and students!
