A Note From Our Principal

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Last year we had a wild winter, and this year we seem to be having a fairly mild winter. Let's hope this continues. Students play outside at recess daily when the weather is above 10 with the windchill and is not overly wet. Students also enjoy playing in the snow, but they must be wearing snow pants and boots with their winter coats.

We will start the Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) in mid March. This is the statewide assessment based on the Illinois Learning Standards. Our third and fourth graders will take multiple sessions of the IAR test. We are currently planning on taking the Reading and Writing portions of the test before spring break and the Math portions after spring break. Make-up testing will happen throughout the 5 week window until testing is completed. Your child's teacher will inform you when their class is testing.

Please consider these three steps to supporting your child through testing:

- 1. Encourage your child to work hard and try his/her best to show how much he/she has learned. Be cautious not to over stress doing well, but continually encourage your child to try hard.
- 2. Limit night time activities on testing eves. Being out or up too late can affect how kids do on tests. To the extent possible, stick to normal bedtimes and set an alarm in the morning to not be too rushed.
- 3. There is something to be said for a good healthy breakfast on the day of the test. Choose energy boosting foods with protein, such as eggs, milk, or yogurt, and healthy carbohydrates, such as fruit, oatmeal, or toast.
