A Note From Our Principal

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are working slowly to become more normal here at Manchester. Shortened exclusions and Test to Stay have definitely been helpful. We have started bringing volunteers into the building and would love to see more. If you would like to volunteer with your child's classroom, please reach out to the homeroom teacher. If you would like to become a volunteer to help throughout the building, please reach out to the office. Volunteers will need to fill out a once a year volunteer form and self certify that they are feeling healthy.

We will start the Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) in early March. This is the statewide assessment based on the Illinois Learning Standards. Our third and fourth graders will take multiple sessions of the IAR test. We are currently planning on taking the tests before Spring Break. Make-up testing will happen throughout the window until testing is completed. Your child's teacher will inform you when their class is testing.

Please consider these three steps to supporting your child through testing:

Encourage your child to work hard and try his/her best to show how much he/she has learned. Be cautious not to over stress doing well, but continually encourage your child to try hard.

Limit night time activities on testing eves. Being out or up too late can affect how kids do on tests. To the extent possible, stick to normal bedtimes and set an alarm in the morning to not be too rushed.

There is something to be said for a good healthy breakfast on the day of the test. Choose energy boosting foods with protein, such as eggs, milk, or yogurt, and healthy carbohydrates, such as fruit, oatmeal, or toast.

Our district is currently conducting the year state required 5 Essentials Survey https://survey.5-essentials.org/Illinois/. This survey helps us to know how we are doing and analyze the effectiveness of changes we have made in the building. When you take the survey, please send in a picture/screenshot of the completion screen, and we will give 3 Bobcat Bucks to your child. I also want to thank all of the families that took the time to take the K-2 SEL survey. The information you provide in these surveys helps our school to make better educational decisions for your children!


