Summer Health Tips

- Drink plenty of fluids, especially water. Stay hydrated!
- Take rest periods in the shade, when possible.
- Keep your skin protected from the sun wear sunscreen and comfortable clothing.
- Get plenty of sleep and eat healthy. Try a new seasonal fruit or veggie!
- Enjoy the outdoors and keep moving. Try hiking, biking, or camping.
- Be aware of biting/stinging insects such as bees, wasps, and mosquitos. Use a good insect repellent. Speak with your doctor for an EpiPen, if allergic to specific insect bites.
- Be careful when playing in tall grassy areas. Ticks can be a problem. Inspect your clothing and body. Use tick repellents as tolerated.
- Keep food safety in mind when grilling or picnicking. Keep food items cold until you are ready to eat. Store in a cooler or refrigerator until ready to serve.
- Water safety: Know your skill level with swimming. Don't dive into waters you are not aware of, especially shallow waters. Swim with a friend or family member. Take breaks and protect your skin.
- Always wash your hands and often!!! Best defense against illness.
