Scrip Program

PGE will once again be participating in the Scrip program. Scrip is a program that allows us to purchase gift cards at a discount. We then sell them at the gift card's face value to you. We can earn anywhere from 1% -25% back on the cards. The earnings go towards our Perfect Attendance and PBIS programs.

To participate in the Scrip program just watch for order forms to come home twice a month. You then fill them out and return them to school with the payment by the due date. We will have your order available to pick up in the office on the 1st and 3rd Fridays of each month.

This is a great program and easy to use. Be thinking about purchasing gift cards for gifts and to do your normal shopping.

Weather will be turning colder so please make sure your student comes with jackets, gloves, hats, boots and snowpants as necessary.
Students will continue to have recess and or PE outside unless the windchill is below 10 degrees.

Notes From The Nurse

With head lice season just around the corner, here are some measures to help keep the situation under control.

Symptoms include itching, particularly behind the ears or at the nape of the neck. Nits are the eggs that lice lay. They are very small, white or yellowish and look like dandruff or hairspray droplets. They attach firmly to the hair shaft. Transmission is by direct contact with an infected person's head or from personal items such as hats, combs, hair brushes & bedding. Lice do not jump or fly and you can not get lice from animals.

Treatment involves shampooing all household members with prescription or special over the counter shampoo. Put on clean clothes after shampooing. Repeat shampoo treatment in 10 days. Use a fine toothed comb to remove all nits, as the school does have a "nit-free" policy. After shampooing, household items will need to be cleaned. Most clothing, towels & bed linens can be washed in hot water or put in the dryer for at least 20 minutes on the hot cycle. Place all non-washable personal items, such as stuffed animals & dolls, into a plastic bag & store for at least 10 days. Clean combs & brushes in hot water, boiling for 10 minutes or soaking in medicated shampoo. You will need to thoroughly vacuum or clean upholstered furniture, mattresses, car seats & car interiors. Fumigating rooms or using an insecticidal spray is not recommended. Vacuuming of the house & rooms is sufficient.

In the event that you do find that your child has lice, please contact the school office so that we can continue to monitor the situation closely. Your child will need to be checked to make sure that they are nit-free when they return to school. The child's classroom is also then checked to help prevent the spread of lice.

Picture Retakes

Lifetouch will be here on the morning of Wednesday, October 25 for picture retakes. If your student was absent the day of pictures they will be photographed. If your student requires retakes, please send their picture packet back to school before the 25th with RETAKE marked on the outside. We will not be able to do retakes without an order form or a picture packet. This will be your student's last chance for fall photos.

Just a reminder...It is in our policy that if a student does not participate in PE, they must also not participate in recess. There will be a table in the lunch room for them to sit and draw or play games. Thank you!
