One of the most reliable predictors of school success is regular attendance. Absences for any reason result in lost instruction time. We know that students who fall behind often become discouraged learners. It is our hope that we can work together to encourage your child's regular attendance and success at school. We understand that there are many factors in your lives that make it difficult, at times, for your child to be in school or on time. However, it is important that we work with you to reduce these to an absolute minimum. Please remember that your child is expected to be in his or her classroom at 8:00 a.m. The first bell rings at 7:55 a.m. giving your child 5 minutes to hang up their coat, return homework, etc. This morning class time is one of the most important times of the day. When a child comes in late, not only have they missed valuable class time, it is disruptive to his or her classmates.

Lastly, each year we have to remind ourselves of the important role we have as models for our students. Children are consummate observers, and they watch our every move and hear every word, including the tones in our voices. If we want them to follow rules and act in kind ways, then we must do the same, consistently. Every time we are rude to others, discourteous, or speak in an unkind way to someone in our community, we give them license to do the same. Let's work together to ensure their success.

Notes From The Office

- If you need to change the end of the day dismissal procedure for your child, please notify the school no later than 2:00 pm. This way we are sure to get the correct information to your child.
- If your child is absent from school or will be tardy, please either call or email the school office by 9:00 am. The phone number is 815-765-3113 or you may email PGEoffice@nbcusd.org.
- Students are referred to the Regional Attendance Cooperative if they are unexcused more than 5% of the last 180 days. Please take this into consideration when you plan vacations during the school year. If you know your child is going to be absent for more than a day, please stop by the office and fill out a pre-arranged absence form. The absence is not excused without this paperwork completed. If your child is absent due to illness for more than 3 days, you will need to bring a note from a physician in order for the absence to be excused.

REMEMBER!!!

7:50 am: first bell rings, doors are opened

7:55 am: warning bell rings

8:00 am: final bell rings-All students are required to be in their classrooms by this time or they will be marked tardy.

- All visitors must register in the main office before having access to the building. A driver's license or State Id is required.
 If you do not have one with you, you will not be allowed to go any further into the school building. This allows us to keep each and every student as safe as possible from the moment they enter the school building.
- Lunches are \$2.75/day full price and \$.40 for reduced. Milk may be purchased for cold lunches for \$.40 a carton.
- If you plan on taking your student out of school for vacation or any other reason that is not medically necessary please fill out a pre-arranged absence form prior to the date.
- The safety of our students is important, and from time to time
 we will practice for certain unlikely situations. We will have
 tornado, fire, bus evacuation, and intruder drills. Many
 times we have our local fire department and law enforcement
 present to help. Please discuss the importance of these drills
 with your child.

Notes From The Nurse

- Attention Parents/Guardians of North Boone School District 200 Students: All students in the North Boone School District will have their vision and hearing screened by an Illinois Public Health Department Certified Technician. If there are any parents/guardians who do not want their child screened, they must submit that refusal in writing to their school prior to September 30, 2017.
- You should keep your child home if they have a fever of 99.6 degrees or higher, have been vomiting, have a productive cough, headache, body ache, earache, or a severe sore throat (A minor sore throat is usually not a problem, but a severe sore throat could be strep throat, even if there is no fever. Other symptoms of strep throat in children are headache and upset stomach. Your doctor will perform a test for strep).

Please keep your student home until their fever has been gone for 24 hours without medication.
