Student attendance is very important

If a student will be absent for any reason, please call the school at 815-569-2314. You may call and leave a message at any time.

Chronic attendance issues (absences and/or tardies) will be referred to the principal and the Regional Attendance Cooperative.

Tardy Policy

Students must be in their classrooms by 8:00 a.m. or they will be considered Tardy. Students who arrive after 8:00 a.m. **Parents need to come to the front office and sign their child in.** The parent drop off line can sometimes be long, so please adjust your time accordingly.

Transportation Changes
