

# myON Android App

## Release Notes

### Version 1.0

#### App Features

Your myON subscription includes a free myON app! This app is available in the [Google Play](#) store for Android tablets – search for the keyword “myON”, and select the app.

The app:

- Lets you share Android tablets between students and classes.
- Lets you download up to twenty books to read anytime (even if you don’t have an Internet connection after downloading).
- Keeps track of student reading statistics online and offline, and synchs activity to student myON accounts.
- Makes every book in your myON collection available through the Android tablet for offline reading.
- Lets you select books to download through visual search or through the myON.com website with your web browser.
- Includes book reading scaffolds for audio and highlighting.

#### System Requirements

Your Android tablet must be using a standard version of Android OS version 3.0 or higher to use the myON app. To add accounts and/or books to the app, you must be able to connect to the Internet. Your Android tablet can use the built-in web browser to access [www.myon.com](http://www.myon.com) for full functionality. Use the free myON app (available through Google Play) to read even when there is no Internet connection.

Capstone Digital has certified the following devices for use with the myON Android app. Note that certifications are for the manufacturer and model number, and older or newer versions of the device may not work in the same way.

- Nexus 7
- Samsung Galaxy Tab 7

If your device is not certified, it will most likely still work with the myON app if it meets our recommended system requirements. Try your device with the app and the myON website and determine if the performance is acceptable for your students. For a

## Step-by-Step

After downloading the app, you can immediately read the included Jackie Robinson book. To read other books, you must first load user accounts to the app.

### Loading User Accounts

- 1) Tap the “users”  icon in the top right to see what users are available.
- 2) Press the “link user”  icon to add new user accounts.

*Note: You must be connected to the Internet to add user accounts to the app.*



### Loading: Student Account

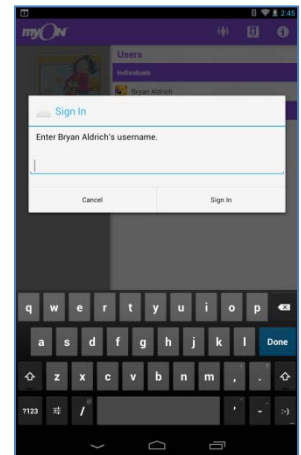
If you are adding a student account, just enter the school name, username, and password (just like logging into myON). The app will record the student as a registered user of the tablet for the myON app. In the future, the student will login by selecting their name and entering the login username.

### Loading: Teacher Account


Adding a teacher account allows the teacher to add their complete class list to the Android app. Login just as you would on the myON website, and select which classes or groups should be added as users to this Android. One tap, and you're done.

### Signing In

Once there are accounts on the Android app, you can sign in to begin downloading and reading other books through the app. Tap the users button in the top right corner to find your name. Now tap your name and enter your login username. You are signed in!  
Note: You do not need to be connected to the Internet to sign in, but must sign in to access the downloaded books for offline reading.



### Adding a Book

Click the “add book”  icon to browse the myON collection of titles to find one you'd like to read. Adding a book through the app opens a visual search, where you can select what category you are interested in.

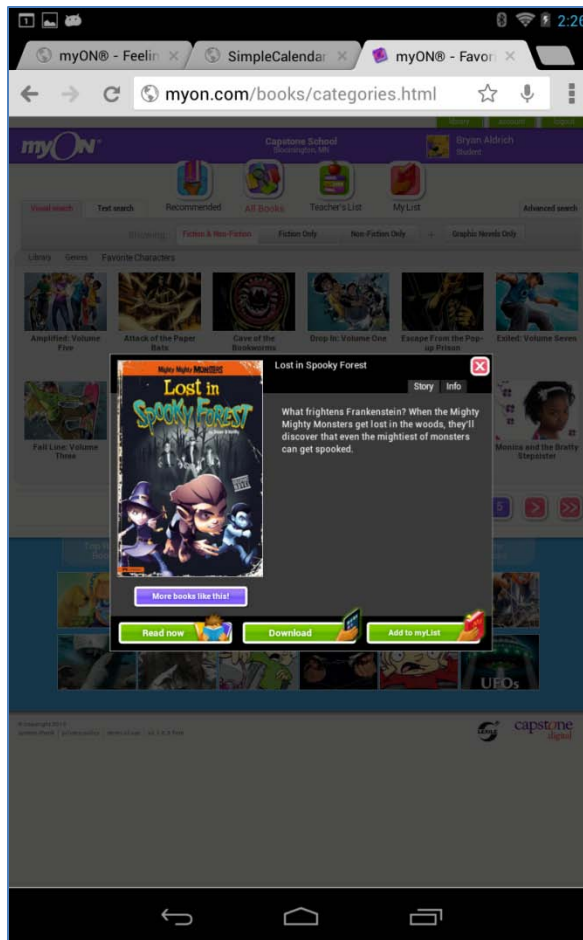
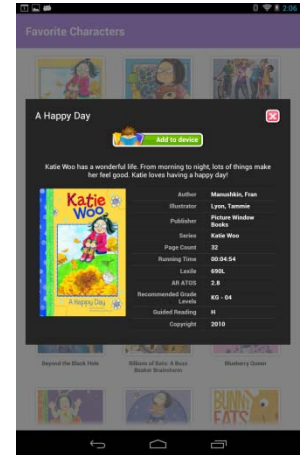




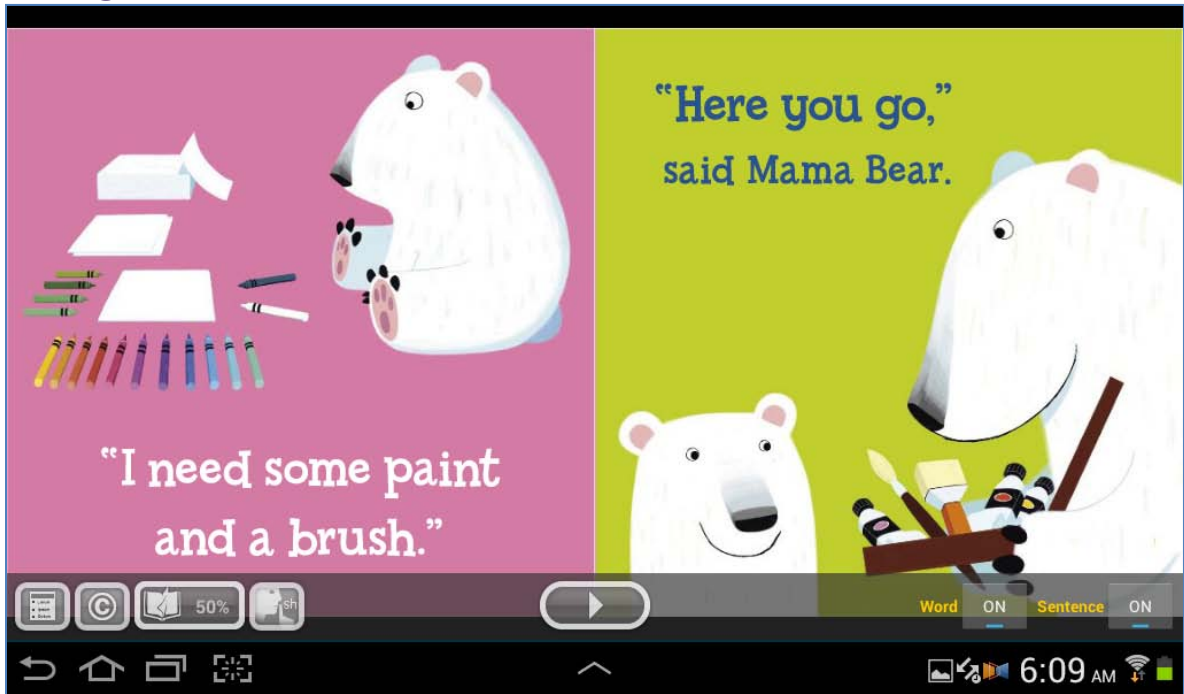
Choosing one of the top levels of categories (like “Animals”) will open a secondary list where you can further refine your search. After your search has been limited by the category, you can select individual titles. Click on a title you are interested in to see download details.

Just choose the “Add to Device” button if this is the book you want to read through the app. If you’ve changed your mind, click the red “x” to close this book and select a different one.

You can also access the myON website through your tablet’s built-in web browser ([www.myon.com](http://www.myon.com)) to find books to download – you’ll see a “download” button which will open your app and add the book automatically to the app for future reading. Clicking “Read Now” allows you to read the book through the myON website, and will not add it to the app for future reading.



## Reading a Book



Once you've selected a book to read, it will open within the app.

- The "Play/Pause" button at the bottom center stops the audio and highlighting. When it's paused, tapping the button will start the audio narration and highlighting again.
- Swipe your finger to turn the page - back and forth.
- Expand two fingers to zoom in on page.
- Pinch two fingers to zoom out from a page.
- Activate the Reader Controls by tapping anywhere on the screen.



The top row icons (from left to right) let you:

- View the backmatter and table of content pages
- View the publisher information about the book
- Jump to any page you've already read
- Mute the audio for silent reading without highlighting
- Pause (or Play) the Audio and Highlighting
- Turn Off (or On) Word Highlighting
- Turn Off (or On) Sentence Highlighting

The bottom row icons are part of your tablet operating system, and may look different based on the tablet that you are using

- Return to the Books page
- Close the myON app
- Additional tablet navigation
